RSV Clinic at Northcrest

Mon, Dec 18 is the date to save. The process is different than other vaccinations.

The process will go as follows:

- Print the attached consent form or pick up a consent form at the front desk.
- Fill out the consent form and turn it into the front desk along with your Part D Plan (your prescription plan) and Northcrest will make a copy of your Part D Plan.
- The consent form and a copy of the Part D Plan will be given to Medicap
- Medicap will then report back to Northcrest which residents are covered under their Part D Plan.
- If you are not covered by your Part D
 Plan there will be an out of pocket expense of \$340.00 to receive the RSV
 vaccination.
- You will receive a phone call from Northcrest if you are not covered and given the option to opt out of getting the RSV vaccination.
- Northcrest will announce times for vaccinations as we get closer to December 18th.
- All consent forms and Part D plans (prescription plan) must be turned into the Front Desk no later than Wed, Dec 13.
