
Bus Guidelines Updated

Beginning this week, you can order four COVID-19 rapid test kits which will be delivered to your home, free of charge. There is a limit of four test kits per residential address and will take approximately 7-12 days to arrive. This is an at-home, antigen test kit that will take approximately 30 minutes to receive results. The website address to order the kits is covidtests.gov.
