Attend a Curator's talk on the new Elizabeth Catlett exhibit.

Catlett (1915 - 2015) was one of the most prominent African American artists of the 20th century. As an artist, she was devoted to creating beautiful and powerful images, with a focus on Black women, motherhood, the Civil Rights movement, and her life in Mexico. Through prints and sculpture, Catlett makes visible with empathy those that were always overlooked in art because of their race. Her own strength and courage were derived from recognizing the strength of her enslaved grandparents and the importance of education modeled by her own parents, which allowed her access to understand her own voice and creativity.
